Dear Mr Zagorodníi,

Regarding your letter in reference and after verification with the European Commission's central services, I would like to communicate you the following.

According to art. 28 (2), 29 (2) and 30 (3) of the Law no. 131 of 03.07.2015 of the Republic of Moldova, notices shall be (also) published by the contracting authority in the "Official Journal of the European Union (OJEU) / Tenders Electronic Daily (TED)". These rules are applicable only for supplies and services contracts whose values are higher than MDL 2.300,000, and for works contracts whose values are higher than MDL 90.000,000. Art. 89 (2) of the Law stipulates that provisions provided in art. 28 par.(2), art. 29 par.(2) and art. 30 par.(3), shall enter into force on 1 January 2019.

A legal basis is needed to enable access to TED for the Republic of Moldova being a non EU Member State. Our services are currently analysing this matter and as soon as it will be clarified, we will be in contact with the Ministry of Finance with further information.

Please also note that tenders financed by projects implemented by the institutions of the European Union, such as European Investment Bank, shall and are allowed to publish contract notices in OJEU/TED.
